In order to maintain a high standard of provision for all users, certain conditions must be accepted by all user organisations. Booking of the Base implies acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

1. A booking fee of £100 (one hundred pounds) is payable and non-returnable.
2. We expect all users of the Base to leave it clean and tidy with particular regard to the kitchen and showers. *ALL* equipment must be used with care and all cooking utensils including the cooker must be thoroughly cleaned before departure.
3. Any breakages or damages must be reported.
4. The Poole and Dorset Adventure Centre accepts no responsibility for loss or damage caused to or suffered by persons using the Base or to third parties. Groups must ensure that their own insurance arrangements are adequate.
5. The only access to the Base is by the track road and students must not stray on to farm land at any time. ***ALL gates must be kept CLOSED.***
6. We would ask that no students are allowed to go to the village (Worth Matravers) unsupervised.
7. Dry-stone walls are a feature of the site and all users are requested not to climb over them.
8. ***Black rubbish bags to be placed in the wooden box outside the building for collection.***
9. No camping on the lawns in front of the dry-stone walls.
10. All parties will be responsible for providing and cooking their own food.
11. No smoking inside the building.
12. All external doors to be unlocked when the building is occupied.
13. The Poole and Dorset Adventure Centre reserve the right to cancel any booking at any time, refunding any deposit paid.
14. Nothing in the above is outside what one is entitled to expect from reasonable users. A great many people have helped to make this Base a pleasant and comfortable place for your use and it is to the advantage of all that the facilities and equipment provided are used with care.
